8:47 Finance Committee Report - Sharon Wynde, Finance Committee Member

- Reviewed FY 23-24 Year End Financials
- Reviewed June Balance Sheet
- The Finance Committee recommends that we amend the Building Reserve Fund Policy to reduce the required balance from \$100k to \$50k. To bring the balance to \$50k, we must also transfer \$11,637.22 from our Unrestricted Reserves into the Building Reserve Fund to make it whole.

- SE Uplift's Reserve Policy states that we must maintain a Building Reserve Fund balance of \$100,000. This is because we own two old buildings that will require expected and unexpected repairs. A reserve amount of \$100,000 was identified as an appropriate amount to be held for these needs. However, in 2023 and 2024, we made substantial investments in our Main Street headquarters to address the most urgent and costly repairs:
 - O We replaced all of the original 1963 plumbing
 - O We installed ductless heat pumps in 2/3rds of the building to replace an aging and inefficient boiler
 - We re-sealed the roof and cleared all of the downspouts
 - O We installed a new sump pump, and cleared the lines to the sewer
- Also, this fiscal year we will take steps toward selling our Tabor Commons property on SE Division Street. SE
 Uplift currently rents this property to Black and Beyond the Binary Collective, who has an interest in
 purchasing it from us. The board, with leadership from the Executive Committee and input from the
 community, will engage in future discussions about formalizing a plan to sell the property.
