7:10 Affordable Housing Opportunity Project (AHOP)

Lead: Bill Cunningham, Bureau of Planning & Sustainability & Guy Benn, TriMet

Background: The Affordable Housing Opportunities Project (AHOP) seeks to address Portland's affordable housing challenges by supporting and preserving affordable housing rezoning properties owned by nonprofit housing providers and public agencies. With 31% of Portland households classified as low-income and cost-burdened, AHOP aims to provide new opportunities for affordable housing development and while preserving existing affordable housing. AHOP ensures that zoning changes contribute to equitable development, long-term affordability, and housing production goals while supporting the Portland Housing Production Strategy.

Status: AHOP is currently proposing zoning map changes to approximately **17 properties located throughout Portland**, 3 are within District 3 with an additional 2 properties along the district boundaries. The properties are owned by nonprofit affordable housing providers and public agencies. The Discussion Draft is now available and receiving **public comment through July 3rd**.
