7:10 **State Land Use Compliance Project**

The [State Land Use Compliance Project](#) provides updates to the Portland Zoning Code to comply with state bills passed in the 2025 and 2026 legislation sessions. The proposed amendments affect middle housing, land use review procedures, and allowed uses including changes to notification, hearing, and appeal requirements. The updates are necessary to [comply with state mandates](#) which limit certain hearings, revise notice requirements, and expanded allowed uses for residential treatment facilities and more. The state mandates affect options for public feedback on development. Learn more about the [project and how to provide feedback](#) before the **June 23rd** Planning Commission hearing.

7:45 **2045 Transportation System Plan**

PBOT will provide a mid-cycle update on the [2045 Transportation System Plan](#) (TSP), the 20-year framework guiding Portland's transportation investments. With the project team refining descriptions and the next pool of major capital projects, this check-in is an opportunity for the committee to offer early, detailed feedback before prioritization is confirmed. Input from committee members is especially valuable for identifying gaps, clarifying project intent, and surfacing District 3 specific needs to shape the candidate list. Previously the Land Use & Transportation Committee at [SE Uplift provided feedback on the goals and visions](#) for the 2045 TSP Committee and advocated for multiple projects included in the project priority list which have helped to shape the project. Committee members are encouraged to discuss with their respective groups the list and share **feedback by July**.
