7:10 **I-5 Rose Quarter Improvement Project**

The **I-5 Rose Quarter Improvement Project** is a safety and congestion-reduction effort focused on the 1.8-mile segment of I-5 where three major interstates converge. The project is currently in Phase 1A construction, which includes stormwater upgrades, bridge work, and extending the southbound auxiliary lane. Upcoming **multiple week closures of I-5** will be required for sign-bridge installation and major deck repairs, and details on detours will be shared so people can plan travel options ahead of construction. Project goals include improving safety, reducing congestion, restoring neighborhood street connections, and building a highway cover that can support future community development in the historic Albina area. Looking ahead, Phase 2 and beyond will depend on securing additional funding and will advance the full highway cover and multimodal street improvements envisioned in the Hybrid 3 design. The City of Portland manages on-street parking and downtown SmartPark garages including the **Area Parking Permit Program** which helps neighborhoods address commuter parking pressures while improving parking access for residents and local businesses. Through a community-led process to establish new parking permit zones, neighborhoods can participate in creating time limits and regulations specific to their community needs. There are additional parking management tools available including the Transportation Wallet, event districts, permit zones, time limits, meters, business and nonprofit permits, and more. Learn about how the City manages parking and what options exist for neighborhoods with parking management solutions that **benefit residents, local businesses, and commuter traffic alike.**

Receive an update on the **Inner Eastside Zoning Project**, which is exploring zoning changes to allow a **broader mix of housing types and small-scale mixed-use development** in Portland's inner eastside neighborhoods so more people can live near jobs, transit, parks, services, and meet their daily needs. The project advances key objectives of the Portland 2035 Comprehensive Plan by supporting housing choice, complete neighborhoods, equitable access to opportunity, and transit-oriented growth. The **Status and Timeline Report** includes the regulatory and legal framework governing legislative land use actions and considerations for an expedited implementation schedule for the project while being consistent with Oregon's Statewide Planning Goals. Learn about **upcoming engagement opportunities** and how to provide input on strategies to increase housing options while supporting affordability, accessibility, and neighborhood livability throughout the 6,931-acre study area.
